

TREE INSTALLATION

WATERING INSTRUCTIONS

- We highly recommend irrigation bags for weekly watering above all
- If not using an irrigation bag:
 - Large trees: Run the hose for 20 minutes in 3-4 locations under the canopy or use a soaker hose for 2-3 hours. Need the water to seep at least 8" deep under the outer branches.
 - Small trees and evergreens: Move aside dense foliage and set the hose on the ground beneath the branches to ensure water is reaching the roots.
- Trees, especially evergreens, shed water like an umbrella, so avoid relying on rainfall or overhead irrigation.

WINTER PREPARATION

- We highly suggest wrapping evergreens in burlap
- We highly suggest installing corrugated pipe or burlap tape around the trunk of deciduous trees
- Ensure 3" layer of mulch around the base if possible
- Be sure to remove irrigation bags before winter to prevent ice buildup between the bag and the tree trunk.

ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS

- Apply a 2-3 inch layer of mulch around the base of the tree, keeping it away from the trunk.
- If the tree is staked, remove the stakes after one year to allow the tree to develop a strong trunk.
- Protect from animal damage, fertilize, & prune correctly.
